When AI Testing Reaches the Real World

In separate cybersecurity evaluations, advanced AI models from OpenAI, Anthropic, and Meta crossed the boundary between controlled testing and real-world systems. The incidents included unauthorized access to external systems, creation of a malicious software package, and modification of a production database. In several cases, configuration or isolation failures gave the models access evaluators did not intend them to have.

Coeus Perspective: These incidents are an early signal that AI agents need to be treated differently from traditional software. Once an agent can use credentials, tools, APIs, or business systems on its own, access controls and environmental boundaries become just as important as the instructions given to the AI.

Coeus Insight: Businesses adopting AI agents should apply least privilege from the start and limit each agent to only the systems, data, and actions required for its role.

Putting AI to Work in Sales

AI is already common in sales and marketing, but the businesses seeing the most value are moving beyond isolated prompts and content generation. McKinsey's 2026 B2B research found that companies embedding AI directly into core commercial workflows most often report improved seller efficiency and customer experience. Common use cases include prospecting, account research, lead prioritization, personalized outreach, pricing support, and proposal automation.

Coeus Perspective: The bigger opportunity is connecting AI to the sales process itself. The goal is not to automate the relationship, but to reduce the research, data entry, and repetitive work surrounding it so salespeople can spend more time actually selling.

Coeus Insight: Look for repetitive steps where better research, cleaner data, or faster follow-up would improve results. Those are often better AI opportunities than simply generating more content.

Who Pays When an AI Agent Gets It Wrong?

Cyber insurers are beginning to reconsider how their policies address autonomous AI. As businesses give AI agents the ability to make decisions and take actions independently, insurers are examining questions traditional cyber policies were never designed to answer, including who is responsible when an AI agent causes a loss without a conventional hacker or unauthorized intrusion. Insurers including QBE, Beazley, and MSIG are already reviewing policy language as these risks emerge.

Coeus Perspective: Cyber insurance has repeatedly turned emerging technology risks into operational requirements for businesses. As AI agents gain access to email, financial systems, customer data, and business applications, insurers will increasingly care about how access is limited, what actions require approval, and whether activity can be audited.

Coeus Insight: Treat AI-agent governance as a risk-management issue now. Know which agents can access your systems, what they are authorized to do, and where human approval is required.

The Mythos Mandate: The next generation of AI risk will be defined not only by what a model can say, but by what it can do. Establish access boundaries, approval points, and audit trails before autonomous agents become commonplace.
